

MINUTES
REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL, CITY OF PERTTULA, TEXAS
Tuesday, October 8, 2019

The City Council of the City of Perttula met in regular session on Tuesday, October 8, 2019, at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers at City Hall, with the following present: Mayor Terry Voss, Alderman Carla Hebert, Alderman Kevin Tran, Alderman Linda Castañeda, Alderman Ruben Ochoa, Alderman Dale Lindqvist. 1. Call to order and establish quorum

Mayor Voss called the meeting to order at 6:01 p.m. and declared a quorum present.
